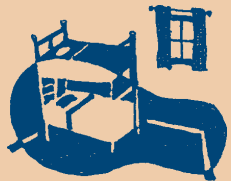

In cooperation with Duke University TIP, Camp Broadstone was proud to host the fifth ASU Scholar weekend on November 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>! Scholar weekend provides opportunities for academically talented students in grades 7-12 to take short courses during weekend-long programs at a college or university. Students spend the weekend on the campus of Appalachian State University and at Camp Broadstone attending courses and having lots of fun! Courses introduce topics that might not be available in students' local schools. Our most recent weekend's courses provided new learning opportunities in Invention and Robotics, Graphic Arts, and Astronomy. Students explored these topics on an accelerated level with the guidance of Appalachian State University's instructors and their assistants. The theme of our most recent weekend's evening program was "mystery." Appalachian State University Recreation Management students provided an evening program unmatched by any other. There were mysteries, clues, suspects, stations at different areas of camp, adventure, and lanterns that led students through a night of excitement and fun. 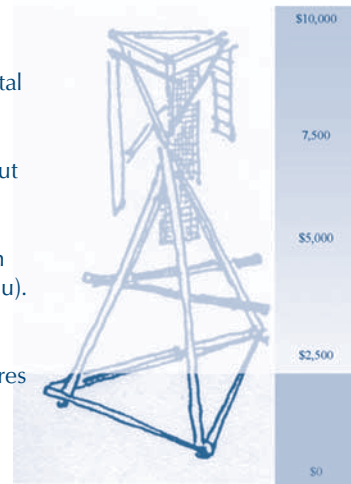
